☐ Read this poem to 2 different people in different voices (scary, funny, whisper, shouting, robot, etc.).

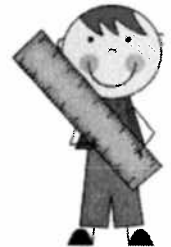
☐ Illustrate this poem on the back of this paper.

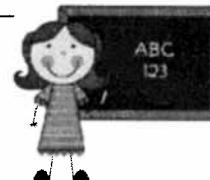

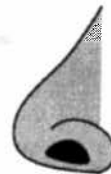
